

LEGISLATIVE ISSUES (cont'd)

HB 10-1094 Here is another move to ensure your right to self defense by extending the right of deadly force use to your place of business. They also inserted an immunity from criminal prosecution for the use of such force. (This is long over due. Contact your Representatives and Senators and push for this bill passage if you are so inclined)

SB 10-057 Non motorized Vehicle Late Registration Fee - Repealed!! When SB 09-108 was passed last year, it applied to ALL vehicles. Now it appears that the Legislature has seen the error of their ways and have come back to put the law back to where it was as it pertains to trailers, fifth wheels, etc.

The Late fee for this type of vehicle will be returned to the waivable fee of up to \$10 that was previously in effect prior to the passage of SB 09-108. (Sorry, no help for motor homes)

Stay tuned we don't know what is going to happen to these bills as they wind their way thru the process at the capitol.
