In order to camp with your chapter you must pre-register and it must be received by May 7, 2010, otherwise you will be put into the overflow section. This is dry camping (no electric or water).

There are limited electric hookups in the handicap area for those with medical need for electricity. All other handicap spaces will provide only a closer location to the activities.

Specific Directions to the Morgan County Fairgrounds
